

Rehabilitation Services



Bronson offers a full-range of rehabilitation services to help you recover from illness, injury or surgery. Rehabilitation also teaches you ways to prevent injuries and manage physical challenges from ongoing conditions.

One-on-One Treatment

Working with your doctor, Bronson's team of experts develop a treatment plan tailored for you. This plan is designed to return you to the highest possible level of functioning. You will have plenty of opportunities to ask questions. Our therapists are specially trained to explain the changes that have occurred as a result of your specific illness, injury or surgery. They will also explain what can be done to maximize the benefits of therapy.

Occupational Therapy

Occupational therapy is used to help you to lead a more independent, productive life. It addresses the skills needed for:

- Basic self-care — grooming, hygiene, bathing, dressing and eating
- Use of adaptive equipment to enhance independence
- Wheelchair positioning, management and safety
- Use of devices for vision and hearing impairments
- Home management tasks — meal preparation, money management and other household chores

- Hand therapy
- Injured worker program
- Lymphedema treatment (swelling in arms or legs)
- Neurological rehabilitation (stroke, head injury, Parkinson's disease)

- Vestibular (balance) rehabilitation

Physical Therapy

Physical therapy is used to treat your disease or condition using physical means, like stretching or exercise. It addresses the skills needed for:

- Walking
- Balance and coordination
- Joint and muscle pain
- Strength and endurance

Speech-language pathology is used to help you improve or correct communication disorders.

It addresses the skills needed for:

- Clear speech and language expression
- Comprehension
- Swallowing

Speech-language pathology services offered include:

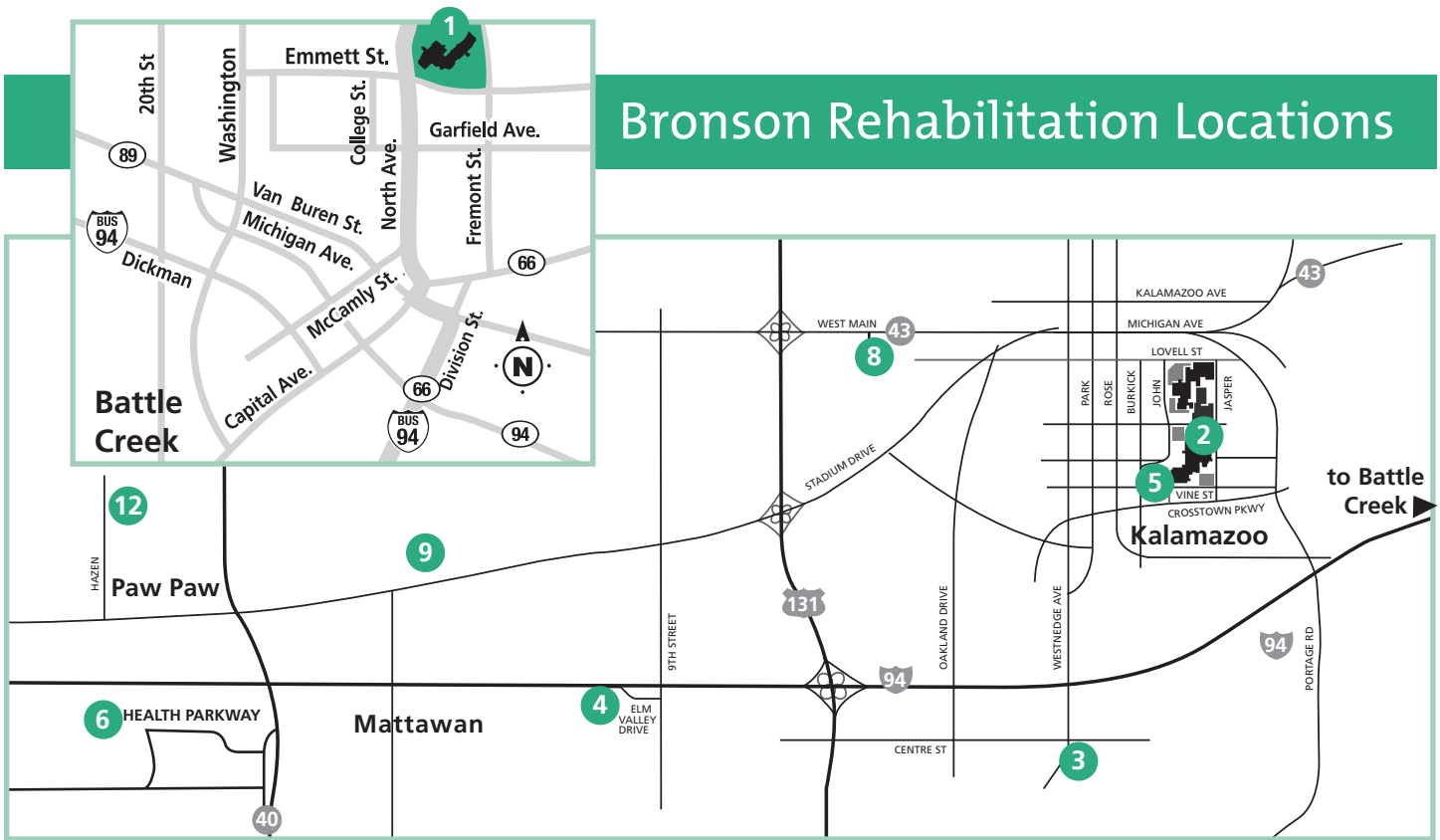
- Cognitive re-education (memory, concentration)
