

Acute Wound and Laceration Follow-up

What is my main problem?

I have stitches or staples to close a wound that needs follow up care. If I cannot go to my own doctor, I can have them removed at the Bronson FastCare or the emergency department.

What I need to do...

Follow my discharge instructions for when to have my stitches or staples removed.

- I can contact my primary care office to make an appointment to have them removed.
- Or I may return to this emergency department at no charge to have them removed. No appointment is needed but I may have to wait to be seen.
- Or I can go to FastCare with no appointment from 8am to 7:45pm Monday through Sunday.

- Bring a list of all the medicines (pills) I take.
- The cost of a FastCare visit is \$75. We will submit to your insurance company.
- Bring all insurance information.

Why it is important for me to do this.

- I need to have my stitches or staples removed to help me heal and not cause more problems.
