

## Breast Imaging Follow Up

### What does BIRADS 3 probably benign mean?

In your mammogram, there was an area that the radiologist would like to check again. Ninety-eight percent of the time there is no cancer. The radiologist just wants to make sure that nothing has changed.

We want to schedule another test in six months. You may need regular tests until the area is known to be stable. This may be for the next 2 years. This testing keeps you from having unneeded biopsies. If the area **does** change, it still allows for early diagnosis.
