



Your insurance may require you to pay one or more of the following:

- a deductible
- a copay
- coinsurance

For more details, please call your insurance company. Use the number listed on the back of your insurance card.

Copay: A fixed amount you pay for a specific healthcare service. You will usually be asked for this payment at the point of service. The amount can vary by the type of service, i.e. emergency department, urgent care, office visit.

Deductible: The amount that you need to pay each policy year before your insurance company starts paying for the cost of your care.

Coinsurance: After you have met your deductible amount, you may need to pay a percent of the bill for a medical visit or treatment. This is what you will need to pay even after your deductible has been met.

Payments can be made at time of service, over the phone or through your Bronson MyChart account. Bronson accepts cash, check or money order payable to Bronson Healthcare Group. We also accept MasterCard, Visa, or Discover as credit card payments.
